Makers dozen

In Farnham, southern England, an exhibition of ceramics, textiles, furniture and calligraphy has just re-opened at the University College for the Creative Arts Crafts Study Centre. *Makers and Movers* features work by 12 artists who, since 1970, have also been trustees of the centre. From early names such as the ceramicist Henry

Hammond and furnituremaker Alan Peters to today's Edmund de Waal and Alison Britton, both ceramicists, and textilemaker Amelia Uden, the exhibition celebrates nearly 40 years of some of the most influential names in British crafts.
